

Drug Facts
Active Ingredients: Ibuprofen USP 10% + Lidocaine HCl 1%
Drug Class: Anti-inflammatory (non-steroidal)
Mode of Action: Reduces tissue concentration of prostaglandins (hormones which produce inflammation and pain).
Uses: Treatment for joint pain, stiffness, inflammation and swelling of arthritis and gout.*
Directions: Apply a small amount of IbuCream™ onto the painful area(s) until thoroughly absorbed into the skin. Repeat as needed up to 4 times per day.
Warnings & Precautions: Do not use if you are allergic to aspirin or any non-steroidal, anti-inflammatory drug. For exterior skin application only and NOT to be taken orally. If your symptoms do NOT improve within 7 days or if they get worse seek immediate medical advice. Do NOT apply to broken skin or burns or into your eyes. If this happens wash with clean cold water and seek immediate medical advice. IbuCream™ is not intended to reduce fever nor to treat headaches.*
